National Traffic Safety Institute (NTSI) awarded Federal Highway Administration Department of Transportation contract to develop Construction Zone Safety Class

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The National Traffic Safety Institute (NTSI) awarded DOT contract to develop and teach construction zone safety classes. NTSI plans to offer these classes throughout the country starting the 2nd quarter in 2007. Paul Hallums, President of NTSI, states "We are extremely honored to be recognized by the federal government for our work. These courses will promote safety in construction work zones, save lives, and reduce the number of work zone incidents."

The DOT contract is the second federal contract NTSI received in 2006. The first contract was awarded by the Installation Management Agency (IMA) to develop curriculum for the Army Traffic Safety Training Program in the spring of 2006. Since that time, NTSI has developed 5 traffic safety courses, including an on-line version, as well as a promotional video distributed to army installations all over the world. As of the date of this press release, the USACRC has reported a significant decrease in the number of traffic accidents.
